### Staatliche Beteiligung am Cyber-Schutz

Cyber-Versicherung hat zweifellos zum Aufbau einer höheren Resilienz beigetragen. Gleichzeitig gibt es Grenzen der Versicherbarkeit. Die Schäden aus katastrophalen systemischen Ereignissen wie einem Cyber-Krieg oder einem Ausfall von kritischer Infrastruktur würden die Kapazität der Branche bei weitem übersteigen. Solche Szenarien bedrohen die makroökonomische Stabilität. Genau aus diesem Grund bedarf es der Mitwirkung von Regierungen bei der Bewältigung dieser potenziell katastrophalen Cyber-Risiken. Jürgen Reinhart, Chief Underwriter Cyber: "Die mit der Digitalisierung einhergehenden Risiken stellen eine gesamtgesellschaftliche Herausforderung dar. Die Versicherungswirtschaft trägt ihren Teil zur Bewältigung dieser Risiken bei. Jedoch können die größten systemischen Cyber-Risiken, etwa der Ausfall kritischer Infrastruktur oder Schäden durch einen Cyber-Krieg, nicht durch den privaten Sektor allein getragen werden. Wir stehen bereit, Regierungen beim Management dieser potenziell katastrophalen systemischen Risiken für unsere Gesellschaften zu unterstützen, indem wir gemeinsam nach alternativen Lösungen suchen."

AI models such as OpenAI's ChatGPT "are just insatiable in terms of their thirst" for electricity, Haas said in an interview. "The more information they gather, the smarter they are, but the more information they gather to get smarter, the more power it takes."

Without greater efficiency, "by the end of the decade, AI data centers could consume as much as 20% to 25% of U.S. power requirements. Today that's probably 4% or less," he said. "That's hardly very sustainable, to be honest with you."

The power issue has drawn growing attention from technology executives in recent months and helped drive up the stock prices of companies that own and operate electric-power plants.

In a January report, the International Energy Agency said a request to ChatGPT requires 2.9 watt-hours of electricity on average—equivalent to turning on a 60-watt lightbulb for just under three minutes. That is nearly 10 times as much as the average Google search. The agency said power demand by the AI industry is expected to grow by at least 10 times between 2023 and 2026.

India's prime minister, Narendra Modi, used AI to help develop the nation's 25-year development roadmap, according to comments made during a live-streamed interview with news agency ANI on Monday.

"I made it subject-wise with the help of AI," stated Modi, according to a machine translation from Hindi to English.

"This is our blueprint for 25 years, which is my own vision now," declared the incumbent seeking re-election.

The publicly traded stock representing **Donald Trump's "media group"** took another dive after Trump and the founders disclosed their intent to take the money and run.

The company's DJT, -16.88% S-1 filing with the Securities and Exchange Commission includes the potential sale of up to 114,750,000 shares held by former President Donald J. Trump.

That amount includes the 78,750,000 common shares he received after the merger with special-purpose acquisition company (SPAC) Digital World Acquisition closed on March 25. It also includes 36 million in "earnout shares," which may be issued to Trump depending on how the stock performs over the next three years.

Trump stands to make another \$950 million from Trump Media—unless the stock plunges again

Despite Trump Media's recent stock slides, the former president is about to be awarded another 36 million shares.

When the <u>questionably leveraged</u> company that rescued <u>Donald Trump</u> with a last-minute \$175 million court <u>bond</u> insured itself with its own parent company, it raised concerns about how the company was playing with its finances.

But now, as even more details come out about that parent company—particularly that it's based in the <u>Cayman Islands</u>, a notorious <u>tax haven</u>—the concerns are just piling up.

Former industry regulators and investigators told The Daily Beast that Knight Specialty Insurance Company being financially backed by a firm based in the <u>Cayman Islands</u> should raise eyebrows at the New York AG's office—particularly because companies frequently organize in the Cayman Islands not just to avoid taxes, but also to minimize visibility into its business practices, avoid more stringent U.S. regulations, and make liability harder should things go wrong.

Americans Have Never Been So Far Behind on Their Credit Card Bills

A new report from the Federal Reserve Bank of Philadelphia provides a glimpse into how Americans are dealing with <u>credit card debt</u> — and the picture is pretty bleak.

The phrase "series high" appears again and again throughout the **short analysis**, underscoring the fact that credit card balances, delinquencies and utilization rates have reached the highest levels since the Philadelphia Fed began tracking

"Credit card performance worsened to historical levels," the report states, noting that the share of folks who fell behind at least 30 days on their credit card payments reached an all-time high between October and December 2023.

Overall, about 3.5% of card balances were past due 30 days or more. The share of people who were further behind on their credit card bills also climbed by the end of the year. Meanwhile, nearly 11% of cardholders were making only the minimum payment possible: another record high.







Q: "Which of the following issues matters to you MOST?"




But the UAW has also filed a complaint with BAFA, the German regulator in charge of the Supply Chain Act, seeking penalties against Mercedes-Benz Group AG:

That's a huge deal, because the German Supply Chain Act goes hard. If Mercedes is convicted of union-busting in Alabama, its German parentcompany faces a fine of 2% of its global total revenue, and will no longer be eligible to sell products to the German government. Chomp.

Now, the German Supply Chain Act is new, and this is the first petition filed by a non-German union with BAFA, so it's not a slam dunk. But supermajorities of Mercedes workers at the Alabama factory have signed UAW cards, and the election is going to happen in May or June. And the UAW - under new leadership, thanks to a revolution that overthrew the corrupt old guard - has its sights set on all the auto-makers in the American south.



Trailing L12M average emissions rate: - France, - Germany, - Germany without nuclear phaseout




#### "EVEN YOUNG GUYS CAN'T STAND TWO YEARS IN THE TRENCHES"

#### What is the current situation with ammunition in your area? Is there enough?

There is a shortage of ammunition, but not so critical, **what is needed now are people**. And the point is not, as many people like to say, that we have a lot of dead. Yes, of course, this is a war, we have losses. But people drop out because they are injured or simply for health reasons. Because even young guys can't stand to spend two years in the trenches, their health is not good enough. And in our army, the average age is probably 40-42. Because we don't have young people going to war, we have men who are over 40. A lot of them leave for health reasons... And fewer come back for various reasons. And this is the main reason why there are not enough people.

If there were more people, it would be much easier for those guys in the trenches, because they would know that they have been in the trenches for two days and then gone on a break for two days. But now he has to sit more. And because of this, morale is already declining, it's harder.

#### INTELLIGENCE UPDATE

- On 19 April 2024, Russia carried out airstrikes using Tu-22M3
  BACKFIRE C strategic bombers likely against targets in southern
  Ukraine. Defence Intelligence of Ukraine announced that they had shot
  down one of the bombers, with reports circulating online that appeared
  to show a single BACKFIRE losing control in the air, and subsequently
  crashing into a field.
- The Russian Ministry of Defence confirmed that a BACKFIRE had crashed and that a Search and Rescue Mission was ongoing but idi not admit to the shoot-down. However, it is almost certain that reports of a S-200 missile (SA-5) being used are accurate and that this was another successful Ukrainian action against the Russian Air Force. This system is likely the same system used to shoot down a Russian A-50 MAINSTAY on 23 February 2024.
- This is the first instance of a strategic bomber being shot down by Ukrainian Air Defence systems. It is highly likely that Russia has now sustained at least 100 fixed-wing combat aircraft losses to date.

# \$10 Million In Gold Disguised As Machine Parts **Seized From Cargo Plane**

Yes, gold smuggling is wrong, but you do kind of have to respect the innovation.

Customs officials in Hong Kong seized 146 kilograms of gold late last month, worth an estimated \$10 million. They discovered the gold on a cargo plane scheduled to leave for Japan, and officials now say the value of the seizure makes it the biggest gold smuggling case in Hong Kong's history. What makes this case especially interesting, though, is that Business Insider reports the gold was disguised as machine parts.






China real GDP growth (%Q/Q ann. & %Y/Y)



China consumer spending and retail sales (real, %Q/Q ann.)






China household savings (% disposable income)
